## Low-Cost Parking

### Off-peak parking permit (\$30/month)

### Flat-rate parking

- Park & Ride Lots: Free!
- Ann-Ashley Structure: \$3 after 4:00 p.m. M-F and all day Sat.
- 415 W. Washington: \$4 M-Sat.
- Liberty Square: \$3 after 3:00 p.m. M-F and all day Sat.

### ½ Price Meters

Park for half the cost of a regular on-street space for up to 10 hours at the following locations:

- 300 & 400 blocks of N. Ashley
- 200 & 400 blocks of N. First
- 400 block of S. Ashley
- 1100 & 1200 blocks of S. State
- 700 block of Packard
